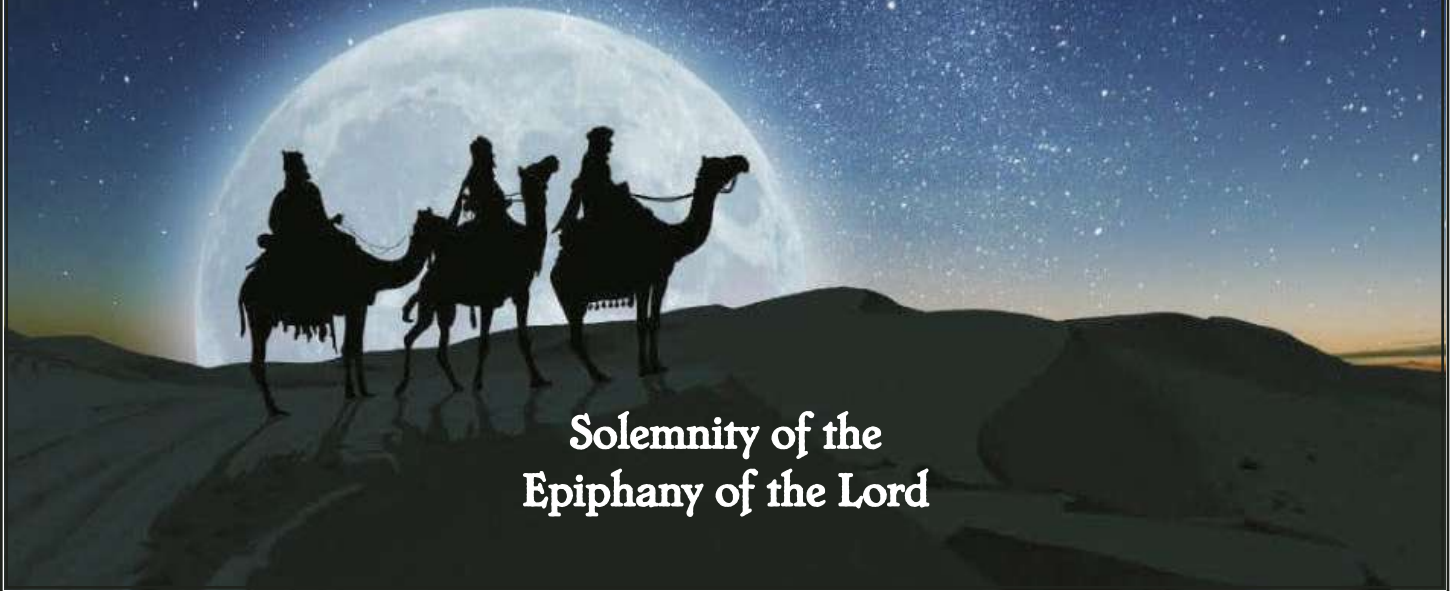

**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word  
Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord**

This word comes from a Greek word that means “manifestation” or “revelation.” You might have heard it in the context of figuring something out: “I’ve had an epiphany!” In the context of today’s celebration, it refers to the revelation of Jesus to the world. It is not a story of the Holy Family traveling and meeting new people, but of people from far away traveling to see Jesus. We know the Magi came from the east, but we don’t know much more than that. Their tracking of the star leads us to believe they might have been some type of astrologers. It was common in that time for learned people to track the stars, which they believed signified important events, like the birth of a king. The important takeaway from their origin is that they were not Jews. They were not part of the people of Israel who professed a belief in God’s promise for the Messiah. They came because they saw the star and believed it would lead them to the new king of the Jews (though this doesn’t mean they believed him to be the promised messiah.) They were searching, and they found the Son of God. In contrast to the Magi who were seeking this newborn king, and who gave him homage when they found him, Herod and the religious leaders of Jerusalem didn’t go searching for this king even though it had been prophesied in their religion. Herod’s request to the Magi might appear that he also wanted to worship the newborn king, but we learn later that he only wished to destroy the child, who could potentially be his political rival. The reaction of the Magi and that of Herod are very different when the news of Jesus’ birth is revealed to them. The Magi, who has no affiliation with the Jewish tradition, give honor to Christ, even if they didn’t know exactly who he was. Perhaps later in life they come to believe. Herod, a Jew, was only concerned with his own interests of power. Sometimes, when Christ’s presence is revealed in our lives, we don’t always react with faith or recognize it as an encounter with God. But, we can learn from the Magi; we should always be open to seeking and following where God leads us.

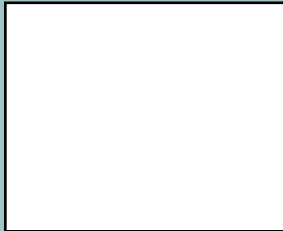

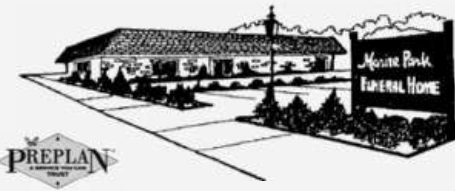
