**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word**  
**Fifth Sunday of Easter**

Last week, we heard Jesus use the image of a shepherd and sheep to describe his relationship with his people. This week, we hear him use the imagery of a vine and branches. This image might be a bit more startling, as Jesus declares that he is the vine and whoever is connected to him will bear fruit, but any branch that does not bear fruit will be thrown into the fire and be burned. Although God desires the salvation of every person, it is our choice, because of our free will, to accept God's offer of salvation or reject it. Those who do reject it in the end will be eternally separated from God. This is what we understand hell to be, eternal separation from God. But our Gospel reading today is not all doom and gloom. Instead, it is a comforting image of what it is like to live in the life of the vine. There is nothing the branches need that they cannot receive from the vine. Jesus' imagery speaks very clearly about our dependence on God; he is our source of life and fruitfulness. All we need is to be connected to Christ, the vine. These obstacles and causes of our struggles should be pruned from our lives so that we can live more fully in Christ. We hear that the gardener, God, prunes the branches. If you have ever gardened, you know the importance of pruning your plants. When plants are pruned, a gardener cuts out all diseased and dying branches because disease can spread from that branch to other areas of the plant if not removed. Thinning out the branches also allows for better air flow and light exposure, which reduces disease and keeps the plant healthy. Pruning makes the branches that remain sturdier and pushes the plant's resources to those existing branches, which produces better-quality fruit. Our spiritual pruning might be painful in the moment, or for a season of life, but it is important to persevere through this process. It helps us to stay on the vine, to stay in Christ. It also allows us to bear more fruit. Our words and actions are better able to lead people to Christ when we are more closely connected to him.

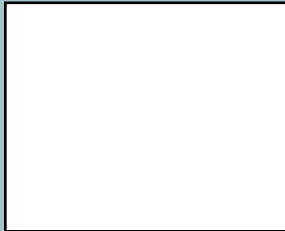

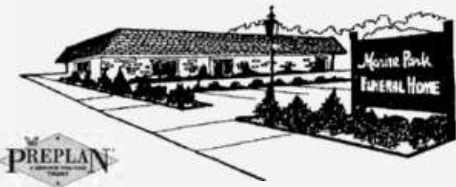
