**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word  
Sixth Sunday of Easter**

Today's Gospel speaks a lot about love. We may use that word everyday but maybe we haven't spent much time reflecting on its meaning. There are different aspects of the love Jesus is talking about today. First, we hear that Jesus loves us as the Father loves him. This is divine love, love that surpasses all or understanding. Later in the reading Jesus instructs us that we are to love each other as he loves us. He loves us with a divine love. He loves us with a love that lays down its life for another. He commands us to love each other in this way. Love involves sacrifice. We might not be called to literally die for someone or to save someone else's life, but we are all called to put the needs of others before our own wants. For example, we might sacrifice hanging out with friends on a Saturday morning to spend time with an elderly relative. Maybe we give up our lunch so that our friend who does not have lunch money can eat. In these small ways, we are giving up part of ourselves for the good of others. Another aspect of the love Jesus talks about in today's Gospel is that we remain in God's love by keeping his commandments. Keeping the commandments, we just discussed is an act of obedience. It takes effort and we must choose to act in that way. We may experience moments when we don't want to love with the love of Jesus. The love of Christ led him to the cross. He was obedient to the Father because he loved the Father and he loved us. He chose to do what was commanded so that God's divine love could be poured out for the salvation of the world. Jesus' love led to obedience. Jesus' obedience led him to the cross. The cross leads to eternal life. Eternal life leads to happiness. Here we see how obedience and sacrifice complement one another in Jesus' example of love. This kind of love is more than just a feeling; it is a way of life and essential to our faith. It leads us to our eternal happiness: life in heaven with God. A final reflection on love has to do with Jesus' bold statement that he, the Son of God, calls us friends. This elevates the value of friendship to something that is not only good but that is holy. Cultivating good friendships helps us tremendously in our spiritual walk with God. When we have supportive friends in faith, we are better able to remain in Christ's love and follow his commands.

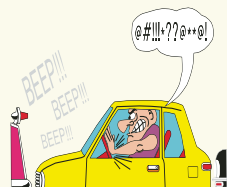

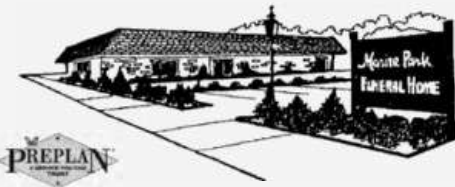
